Confidential Resources

Under Title IX, confidential resources keep reports of sexual misconduct completely confidential and do not report to the College unless the victim consents to the release of information.

Off-campus counselors & advocates: will generally maintain confidentiality and not share information with the college unless the victim requests disclosure.

Confidential Advisors (Illinois Campuses Only)

Confidential advisors/advocates do not have a mandatory reporting duty under Title IX, and do not have to reveal any identifying information about the incident to the College. Any and all communication to these confidential advisors is privileged and confidential. In addition to maintaining confidentiality, these advisors also serve to assist the victim in receiving the necessary protection & support, such as victim advocacy, academic support or accommodations, disability, health or mental services, & changes to living, working, or course schedules.
